HOW TO CARE FOR FUNCTIONAL CLOTH



Use of room temperature water

- Use room temperature water to prevent shrinkage or damage to sensitive fabrics.



Regular drying procedures

- Appropriate drying methods help preserve the performance properties of functional garments.
- Hang damp garments on a line or bar to air dry indoors or outdoors.
- Smooth out wrinkles by reshaping the garment while it dries naturally.



Normal strength of detergent or soap

- Use a mild detergent suitable for delicate fabrics.
- Avoid detergents with bleach or harsh additives.



Regular ironing procedures

- Ironing can help maintain a neat appearance while caring for functional fabrics.
- Iron at a temperature suitable for the fabric type, typically indicated on the garment's care label.
- Use steam as needed to smooth out wrinkles and creases without applying excessive pressure.



Laundered through gentle machine or hand manipulation

- Functional garments can typically withstand machine washing and handwashing.
- Select a gentle cycle on your washing machine to minimize agitation and reduce wear on the fabric.
- For more delicate or intricate items, hand washing is recommended.
- Gently swirl the garment in the water, avoiding excessive rubbing or twisting to maintain fabric integrity.



Avoiding heat

- Not all functional garments are suitable for dry cleaning.
- Avoid using mechanical dryers, as heat can cause shrinkage or damage to technical fabrics.
- Check the care label for specific instructions regarding dry cleaning.
- If unsure, consult with a professional cleaner experienced in handling technical fabrics to ensure proper care and maintenance.



Avoid chlorine or bleach

- For garments with nano-finishes, refrain from using any bleach products, including detergents that contain bleach.
